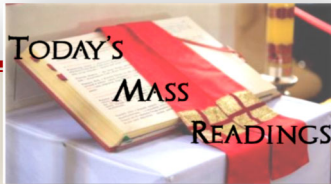

Family to Family is a box filled with food that your family packs for another family for Thanksgiving. 3 Different boxes: Small, Medium, Large

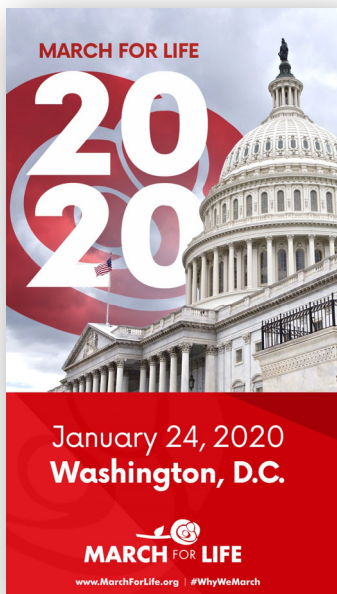

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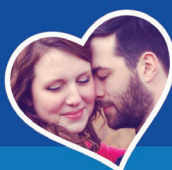
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
