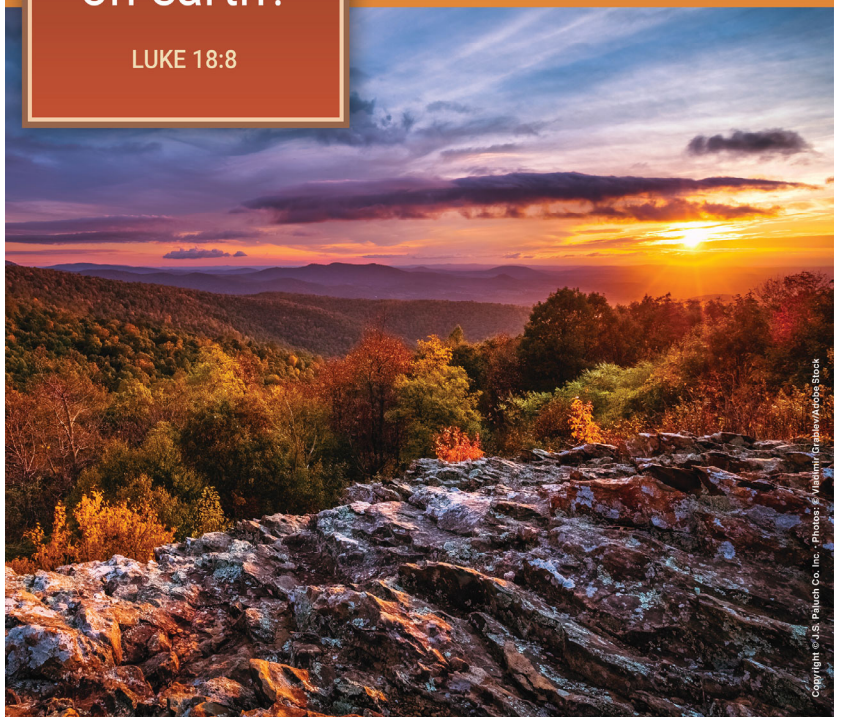

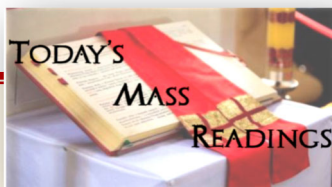

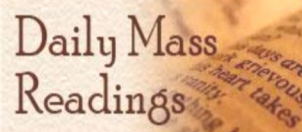


First Reading -- As long as Moses kept his hands raised up, Israel had the better of the fight (Exodus 17:8-13).

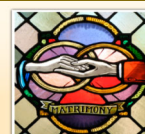

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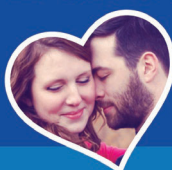
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
